Brief History

Lead India 2020 was established in the year 2004 based on the vision articulated by Dr APJ Kalam, "India to transform into a developed nation by the year 2020 by empowering youth to develop themselves into confident, responsible citizen working towards self, family, community development thereby leading India towards a developed nation. In this direction, Aap Badho Desh ko Badao (ABDB) training program was developed as the primary vehicle to accomplish Dr Kalam's vision and it was based on AcharyaKalam Human Transformation Model at its core. During the years 2004-2019, ABDB training program was imparted to over 15 Lakhs students in over 7000 schools in 51 districts covering 9 states; over 6000 teachers and 3000+ principals were also trained. However, in order to scale up ABDB program to cover the entire nation with a significant and measurable impact, LIF is now taking a very a strategic and pragmatic approach that would translate LIF vision into actions leading to outcomes with measurable and time bound impact. In order to accomplish this LIF intends to become a standalone, independent, professionally managed, globally respected, Institution with transparent governance and highest ethical and moral standards supported by the required resources. This will be driven by a well-documented vision, mission and strategy with core values and will be managed by a full-time management team with a multi-layer transparent governance structure in place. Given Lead India 2020 has reached its major milestone this year, the board has decided to change its name to Lead India Foundation (LIF) while drawing a road map for its journey through the year 2030 and beyond.

Aap Badho Desh Ko Badho" (ABDB) training program

This training transforms a person on different dimensions of "Aap – Self". This will help students

with Life realities, challenges, life skills. Thinking skills, altering attitudes and to develop individually, setting up high Goals and action plans. The core principles "Compare and Compete

with Self". Work continuously to achieve goals with self-introspection, practice values and skills

to develop themselves, their families and communities and nation.

ABDB program is training and research-based, experiential, result oriented, transformative and unique educational movement to create incredible human capital by bringing transformation in the basic human planes i.e. physical, mental, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual Unique feature of inculcation of human values is based on the hypothesis that "Values are not taught but they are caught".

ABDB – National Development – Sustainable Development Programmes

This programme has inspired lakhs of individuals. It continues to inspire in practicing great Cultural values of ancient India and realising that National problems must be solved from individual level. Greediness is the root cause for the main problem, Corruption. 1,00,000 Lead India trained students (Change agents) of Chittoor district have submitted a garland of post cards to then President, Dr. Kalam with parents' signatures and with a message," We will not sell votes for Notes". They are also teaching their parents to read and write. They also stopped bad habits such as drinking, smoking, etc., they worked on planting trees for acquiring Lead India Social Credits. Patriotic sessions make them to take an oath stating that "I am Indian First" beyond any differences of caste/region/religions/languages etc.

Lead India National Clubs (LINC)

After ABDB trainings for sustenance Lead India National Clubs (LINCs) are established at institution level under the Chairmanship of institution's Principal with Co-chairmanship of Patriotic faculty along with student representatives from different classes as Change agents. These Change agents are trained as trainers and developed as Leaders with Critical Mass Leadership Development Programs (CMLDP). They train their classmates, juniors on ABDB and Human Values. They take up responsibilities of different groups such as Educational, Scientific, Sports, Cultural, Literary, Discipline, stopping any ragging at school, Swachh Bharat with Swachh Mann, Employable skills, Entrepreneurship skills, etc. On providing evidence and on the recommendation of the Principal, Lead India Social Credits are issued to the students.

Critical Mass Leadership Development (CMLD) Program

After training programme, Select the best three students from each class (VII, VIII, IX & X) as change agents who should be able to train other students. These selected change agents may be undergone the Critical Mass Leadership Development Quarterly Programme (CMLDP) for 2 days at Mandal/district level. Using "Train the Trainers model and peer group influence converts students as teachers and change agents takes up the responsibility of themselves, schools, their own families, communities, nation, and humanity. This model besides imparting real life skills creates a large pool of global resource cadre for economic development. These change agents after CMLDP will be given summer community development projects to bring back dropouts, girl children and imparting functional literacy for their family members and neighbours, Lead India will be issued Lead India National credits. Students will develop global skills like leadership skills, teamwork, communication skills etc..., to grab global opportunities lead India 2020 is giving a unique ID to each Change agent and tracking beyond schools and hand holding them till they realize their goals or up to 2020.




























Corporate Trainings conducted


