The report covers the LIF Mission 2047 – VGB Activity Report for 2025–2026, reviving Lead India 2020 and Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam's vision, aligned with Swami Vivekananda's Vishwa Guru Bharat and the Government of India's Viksit Bharat @2047 (launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on December 11, 2023).

#### **Key Highlights:**

The foundation carries four decades of research through the Acharya Kalam National Transformative Model (ABDB) , focusing on BPL students in government schools to support UNO Sustainable Development Goal No. 1.

India has 28 crore students; the model addresses gaps in metaphysical education (mind, intellect, emotions, beliefs, rituals, spiritual education) to unlock hidden potential.
